Day	Activity	Equipment required
Monday	Coastal walk and day at the beach. Beach games and activities	Suitable shoes and clothing to walk the coastal path, flipflops and sandals are not appropriate. Recommended is a small backpack to carry extra sun cream, sunhat, plenty of fluids and packed lunch.
Tuesday	Cinema trip	A packed lunch. It is optional to bring some money for popcorn and drinks at the cinema
Wednesday	Climbing at Sardine Factory Walk to the Sardine Factory and a play on the beach afterwards	Clothes suitable to rock climbing and to play on the beach afterwards in. A small backpack to carry packed lunch, water, sun cream, sun hat



Thursday	Sports games in the morning Film in the afternoon	Wear clothes you are happy to run around in, sun hat, sun cream
Friday	Glass bottom boat trip in the morning and back to school for lunch for games and sporting activities for the afternoon	A small backpack to carry sun cream, sunhat, plenty of fluids, packed lunch.
